Job Description: Actor

Serving as an ACTOR is a crucial part of the journey of putting on a production. It is intended to be a learning vehicle as well as a valuable aid to the success of any production. All & Sundry maybe an amateur company however we pride ourselves in putting on professional productions.

The duties of an ACTOR are as follows:

- Attend ALL rehearsals and performances
- Follow instructions given by the Director, write your personal stage directions on your script (This is *your* responsibility)
- Inform the Director if you are unable to attend any rehearsals (Unless due to illness) before you accept the role, if you do not attend a rehearsal this not only affects you and your Director but your fellow cast members too
- Together with the Director, liaise with the Wardrobe Mistress and Producer over who will supply props and costumes for your character
- Please ensure you have paid your annual membership (£20.00 for 18 and over and £10.00 under 18)
- Make sure you pay your subs - £1 (50p for panto) at each rehearsal
- LEARN your lines and be script down on the date given by the Director (There will be NO prompt at the theatre!)
- Be respectful to fellow members of the cast and production team
- Should the Director be unable to attend a rehearsal then you will follow the instructions of the Assistant Director
- When in the theatre please follow their rules, be respectful to the management, no talking backstage, NO scripts or part thereof allowed on stage, no alcohol must be consumed backstage or in your dressing room, this is unprofessional and totally forbidden
- Any other reasonable duties from time to time, as requested by the Director, for example, helping with the set build, promoting the production by handing out flyers, social media etc.
